PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Nursing – Traditional BSN at the Ila Faye Miller School of Nursing and Health Professions at the University of the Incarnate Word prepares graduates to take the licensure examination to become a Registered Nurse (RN). Nursing courses include clinical experiences in a variety of settings with clients across the lifespan. Our nursing education building includes a modern clinical learning center that offers high fidelity simulated learning experiences. UIW graduates are employed around the world in all areas of healthcare including hospitals, community settings, research, education, parish ministries, government agencies and the military services.

A minimum of 123 hours is required for graduation.

- The Traditional BSN track is approved by the [Texas Board of Nursing](#) and accredited by the [Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education](#).
- The UIW Traditional BSN is a five-semester program that requires 28 months to complete.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admissions to the B.S. in Nursing – Traditional BSN is a two-part application. Students must be admitted for general admission into the University of the Incarnate Word before applying to the Traditional BSN program.

Applicants apply to the Traditional BSN program while completing prerequisite coursework. Applications must be submitted to the Ila Faye School of Nursing and Health Professions by February 1 for fall admission and July 1 for spring admission each year.
