PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The University of the Incarnate Word's post-baccalaureate Doctor of Nursing (DNP) degree with a concentration in the Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) role is designed to prepare registered nurses for advanced nursing practice. Courses within the program are offered in blended formats with online, on-campus and clinical experience opportunities.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of a baccalaureate degree in nursing from a CCNE or NLN accredited program which includes statistics and health assessment courses
- Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above with a 3.0 in higher level nursing courses
- Current unencumbered license to practice nursing in the State of Texas or one of the compact states recognized by Texas
- Minimum of 1 year of experience in professional nursing preferred, but not required
